The modern infrastructure is qualified and highly secured which provided by UnionPay International, a global leading payment company and available in world wide. The service will be a new payment channel besides to debit or/and credit cards payment.

This collaborative project will be a significant step to enhance shops and businesses in Lao PDR and will attract Chinese tourists' spending to the Lao PDR since it is an easy way to make payment. The service will also boost shops' sales due to the modern system and will attract larger customer group. As result, it will grow the commerce and payment between the two nations.

UnionPay application has more than 150 million users throughout China which is the app is now the most popular app in China. Furthermore, the rate of Chinese tourists and investors who visit Lao PDR tends to grow increasingly and continuously which there has been more than eight hundred thousand people per year. Chinese is the biggest tourist group in Lao PDR and this year is the tourism promoting year of Lao PDR and China under the name "*Visit Laos-China Year 2019*" which would raise the number of Chinese tourists and investors in the Lao PDR.
