

BCEL Annouces Succesful Conculsion of Extra-Ordinary General Shaeholders' Meeting for the year 2025



On the afternoon of Friday, September 5, 2025.

Banque Pour Le Commerce Exterieur Lao Public (BCEL) held its Extra-Ordinary General Shareholders' Meeting 2025 at 2:30 PM at the Lao Plaza Hotel in Vientiane Capital.



The meeting was chaired by Mr. Soulivath Souvannachoumkham. Vice Minister of Finance (Laos) and Chairman of the BCEL Board of Directors. The meeting has the participants of the BCEL Board of Directors, Directors, Division Management, along with representatives from the Bank Supervision Department, the Lao Securities Commission Office, and the Lao Securities Exchange.

A total of 30 shareholders attended the meeting in person, while 120 shareholders attended by proxy, bringing the total shares represented at the meeting to 779,784,250, including 3,690,685 proxy shares. This represents 75.079% of BCEL's total shares.



The meeting proceeded with a comprehensive agenda and provided shareholders with an open opportunity to raise questions. The BCEL management team clarified each issue with transparency and clarity. Key resolutions and decisions were made as follows:

Saysamone Chanthachack, Managing Director of **BCEL**, assured the shareholders that the executive management is committed to implementing the 2025 business plan to achieve targets its and maximize profitability, thereby safeguarding the interests of both the organization and its shareholders.

- 2) Approval of Amendment to the BCEL Business Plan for 2025.
- 3) Appointment of Ms. Bounta Daravy as the new Vice Chairman of the BCEL Board of Directors, succeeding Dr. Akhom Praseuth, whose term had ended.
- 4) Appointment of Mr. Michael De Clercq, Managing Director of the Banque Franco -Lao (BFL) (COFIBRED Representative), as a member of the **BCEL** Board new Directors, replacing Mr. Arnaud Delaunay.
